**How does my membership with the Minnesota Companion Rabbit Society help?**

MCRS memberships pay for the ongoing expenses associated with our adoption and educational efforts. Members receive the New Rabbit Thymes newsletter and a “Golden Carrot” certificate of thanks. Bunny Backers pay for all costs associated with caring for one already-altered rabbit, including medical treatment and daily needs until the rabbit is adopted. Sponsor-A-Foster members do the same for one un-altered rabbit, and provide his or her neuter/spay surgery, as well. They both receive the New Rabbit Thymes newsletter, a Certificate of Sponsorship, updates on their sponsored rabbit, and recognition in the newsletter.

MCRS Guardian Angels give a specified amount every month for a minimum of one year. You will receive twelve envelopes to use for your contributions each year. Guardian Angels provide the steady income that we rely on to care for MCRS foster rabbits.
